Nerine

Nerine masonorum: Fine thread like foliage. The 25cm flower stem has upwards of six soft pink flowers. The petals are slightly undulated giving a frilly effect. These dainty dwarf bulbs are quite distinct from their larger cousins. They are ideal for pockets in a rockery. They *do not* like potting mix. If grown in a pot they do best in a very well drained garden loam containing about 30% coarse river gravel. **10 for \$30.00**

Nerine bowdenii: Large bright pink heads, vigorous grower.
Flowers late autumn.

Pleione Orchids:

These delightful little orchids are native to the Himalayas and are a cold climate orchid that does best outdoors. The bulbs should be grown in a cool shady position such as a fernery. They produce a startling orchid flower in early spring followed by the foliage. Height 12-15cm.

Pleione formosanum: Lilac petals with light brown markings in the throat.

Tigridia pavonia "Jockey's Caps"

The bulbs produce dazzling flowers in early to mid summer. Although the flowers are short lived, each 50cm stem produces a succession of blooms over several weeks. Each bloom can be up to 13cm (5") across. The flower centre is heavily spotted and surrounded by three wide pointed petals. Mixed colours only of red, orange-pink and yellow.

“Hesperus”: Very unusual blooms, deep pink intermingled with peach, very bright.

“Kinshe”: Very large full double yellow apricot flowers with an orange crimson blush.

“Rimpo”: Large deep mauve petals with a darker purple base contrasted by the golden anthers.

“Rose Flame”: A lovely semi double rose coloured bloom. Very pretty.

“Savage Splendour”: Unusual apricot coloured blooms with messy petals.

“Thunderbolt”: The single flower is a vivid scarlet red.

Herbaceous Peony Rose (Not for WA)

These long-lived perennials are happiest in areas with a cold winter and a bright clear spring. Generally they take a couple of years to settle down and bloom freely, but the patience is well worth it. The flowers appear early summer. In warmer districts they *may* be induced to flower by placing a block of ice once a week, on top of the clump during winter.
